ORAL HISTORY INTERVIEW CONSENT FORM

The Oral History Collection of the Preserve the Baltimore Uprising Archive Project is composed of recorded interviews with individuals who can give first-hand accounts of some aspect of the events protests that followed the death of Freddie Gray on April 19, 2015. Interviews are obtained both from well-known leaders in Baltimore City and the surrounding area and from others who otherwise would likely not appear in any other historical record. The goal is to supplement and enhance the collections of the Preserve the Baltimore Uprising Archive Project.

You have been asked to give an interview to an interviewer on behalf of the Preserve the Baltimore Uprising Archive. A recording of your interview will be made by the interviewer. In some cases a verbatim transcript will be made. In every case an abstract will be made of the recording.

Recordings, abstracts and transcripts will be deposited online at the Preserve the Baltimore Uprising Archive www.BaltimoreUprising2015.org. These materials will be made available for research, educational use, scholarly publications, and other related purposes.
