Businesses and job seekers impacted by the recent events in Baltimore are encouraged to use the services provided by the city's two, One-Stop Career Centers and its four Satellite Employment Centers – operated by the Mayor's Office of Employment Development. For businesses, services include:

- Outplacement support
- No-cost job posting, outreach and recruitment
- Applicant pre-screening
- Tax credit for hiring

For job seekers, services include:

- Job placement assistance
- Job search and referral
- Resume and job preparation assistance
- Occupational skills training
- Skill level identification and assessment
